A Children's Stroller is a vehicle designed to carry one or more children. It is a means of transportation for infants that requires someone to help push or pull them. Children's strollers are generally composed of textiles (e.g., cushions and awnings), metals (e.g., canopy supports and frames,), plastics (e.g., small wheels, foot pedals, and handrails) and anti-haze covers. Strollers are used for infants and young children who have poor self-protection awareness and are often vulnerable to accidents. So the safety performance of strollers is very important. Europe	EN 1888	 Applicable to pushchairs and prams designed for the carriage of one or more children. EN 1888-1, up to 15kg each and up to 20kg for any integrated platform on which a child can stand. EN 1888-2, above 15kg up to 22kg each. Does not cover toys, baby carriers fitted with wheels, pushchairs and prams propelled by a motor, and pushchairs and prams designed for children with special needs.
USA	16 CFR 1227 ASTM F833	 Applicable to carriage and strollers for infants or children. Stroller: designed for the transport of infants or children generally in an upright sitting or semi-reclined position. The motive power is supplied by a person moving at walking speed while pushing on a handle attached to the stroller. It is normally used for children from infancy to 36 months of age. Carriage: designed for the transport of an infant who is generally in a lying down position. The motive power is supplied by a person or persons pushing or pulling on a handle attached to the vehicle. Does not cover tricycles, bicycles, or other similar wheeled products that can be self-propelled, even if the item has a temporary or permanent handle.
China	GB 14748	 Applicable to pushchairs and prams designed for the carriage of one or more children. Does not cover toys, pushchairs and prams designed for other special needs.
Australian	AS 2088	 Applicable to convertible vehicles, wagon-type vehicles; and other vehicles that are able to be pushed by a carer in a stroller mode to transport one or more children. Not apply to learner tricycles, wheeled suitcases; and ride-on toys
